The architecture program has certain endowed scholarships that support architecture students in ARCH Education Abroad venues. These scholarship funds are available on a competitive basis. Follow the steps below to apply for this category of scholarship funding.

### Supporting Materials:

Attach a PDF of your current transcript. You may obtain an unofficial copy of your transcript by visiting [www.testudo.umd.edu](http://www.testudo.umd.edu) and following the instructions on that site.

### Eligibility:

Open to current ARCH Majors. Students must be in academic good standing to qualify. Graduate students must successfully complete ARCH 404 or higher to be eligible. Scholarship support for ARCH Education Abroad programs is limited to students who are currently enrolled in the BS in Architecture, the BA in Architecture, or the M ARCH (or AR\_\_ dual degree) programs. Applicants must have been accepted to an ARCH EA short term or ARCH EA regular term program and intend to participate. Funds are to be used in conjunction with UM ARCH programs only. **All undergraduate applicants must demonstrate that they have applied for additional scholarship support from the [University of Maryland Education Abroad office](#).**
